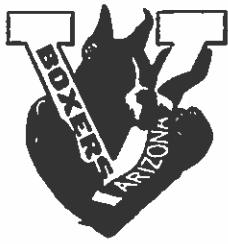

Mr. Barger informed the council that we have 2 new members on the site council Mrs. Frances Massingill and Mrs. Christina Nickerson. Mrs. Massingill will have two children attending Vail Academy and High School one on the elementary side and one on the high school side. Mrs. Nickerson will is a teacher at Desert Sky Middle School and will have a child attend Vail Academy and High School. Mrs. Massingill and Mrs. Nickerson are on the planning committee for the new school. Mr. Barger also talked about the planning committee making lists of things we would like to see at VAHS. We will be a school of choice, go towards STEM, Technology important in school, continue the culture we have at VHS, educate the whole child. Mr. Barger talked about the Site Council meeting as a group with all the other school site council members. Mr. Barger shared with the council the awards assembly at the Vail Theater of the Arts. Teachers give awards from first semester. Mr. Barger will give Honor, High Honor and a Principal Part awards.

F. Recognitions

Mr. Barger recognized Mr. Ogden the government teacher and his classes for hosting a debate among the candidates for Republican nomination for the upcoming general election for district 8. One of these 4 gentlemen will be opposing Congresswoman Gabriel Giffords in November. John Justice from 104.1 Thetruth helped moderate the event. According to the Arizona Daily Star some 350 people were in attendance. State Senator Paton talked with Mr. Barger that he was very impressed with how well the students and Mr. Ogden coordinated the event. All

candidates including State Senator Paton are looking forward to the next Vail High School sponsored debate. Three of the four candidates have been to the school to speak with the students. The fourth candidate is planning a visit with the students soon.

Mr. Barger also recognized Mr. Roberts for helping teachers with Moodle. Moodle is an interactive tool where teachers can post assignments, and resources. It also allows the teacher to quiz students and explain what they got wrong and why. Mr. Barger also explained that we have a new web page and teachers are starting to post information on the new site. Mr. Barger recognized one of our students Liz Kent for contacting a recycling company and was able to get 35 new blue recycle bins.

## 2. Old Business

### A. Enrollment Summary

The number as of today is 154. Mr. Barger shared with the council the numbers are down by 5 from last month not to bad. We lost about 15 students, some were on the waiting list for Empire, a few went to Cienega, a few to VDLP, 1 moved out of state, 1 moved to another district. The students that did leave would have been on academic probation when they came back due to their GPA. VDLP is at 47 full time and 16 part time students.

### B. Construction Update

Mr. Barger informed the council that the construction for the new school has begun and they are well ahead of schedule. As of Monday slabs will be poured for classes. All footer have been dug. Next pour crushed rock then pour 8" slab. By next Wednesday everything should be poured and walls in. Plumbing is 90% done. Ground breaking ceremony will take place on the soccer field Wednesday, February 3<sup>rd</sup>. Mrs. Karakla recreation area concerned with balls going over to I-10. Mr. Barger's response, soccer field is blocked with fence and little kids could not kick over a wall 50 yards away. If bounces over, teachers will go and get it.

### C. Grade Level Caps

Setting grade level caps have talked about previously. At this point we are not set about high school. We have to be flexible with high school foreign exchange students will not come back. If we have 45 seniors how many juniors and sophomores do we take. We are hoping to grow 60 to 75. Mr. Barger's recommendation is to set caps to each grade kindergarten to 20, 1<sup>st</sup> - 3<sup>rd</sup> at 22, 4 - 6<sup>th</sup> at 24 and 7-8 at 25. Mrs. Paral motions to cap grade levels as presented, Mr. Burns seconded all were in favor. Motion to cap grade levels was passes. Discussion. Mrs. Karakla wanted 5 spots and it should be up to parents. Mrs. Massingill disagree that if should be 3. Parents will be turned off. Mr. Barger stated there has to be a max. It should be 3 because Mr. Barger will have to sit with a parent and inform them that they have met the max. If we go down to 18 to do 5 kindergarten 20 and 5 and set at 25. We will take only 20 and add 1 or 2 but not a total of 25. Mr. Burns ask any further discussion approved everyone responded (1) yes.

### D. 10 / 11 Enrollment Update

Vail High School has sent out 60 packets, the majority of them being returned don't have numbers so parents are printing them on-line., K-6=50 packets, 6 enrollment packets, 7 & 8 grade, several for high school. There are about 8-10 packets from staff that have not turned them in. Mrs. Karakla mentioned parents need to know the deadline. During Christmas made phone calls to remind them about enrollment. Packets will increase when the billboard goes up. There has been a lot of advertisement and still people are not aware of what we are doing. Mr. Barger expects a big turnover in the beginning of school. Mr. Burns concern is

extracurricular activities. Mr. Barger responded have not looked at it for middle school. Time will be a conflict missing practice, ext.

**E. 1:1 Laptops**

Mr. Barger recommendation, break tradition explain what happened staff meeting about 1:1. Today at staff meeting made decision new school and market what Empire has but smaller classes? What is VHS going to use? What is cheaper? And what does it cost? Reminder Mr. Jensen brought in a net book. About \$425.00 if we decide windows 7 with \$475.00 Apple released iPad. Too soon if that is what we wanted to use. The price \$499.00. Is this the direction we want to go? Price could go down in a few months. Staff currently wants to go 1:1. Mr. Barger is concerned to inform parents we are going 1:1 but we do not know which device to use. Mr. Barger parents should find out what device on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of school. Mr. Barger what is Empire going to I-Pad or net book. If VHS tell parents that we are waiting because of cost the will understand. Mrs. Karakla parents want best product in their hands, something that will work for them. Mr Barger there is a lot of questions so it seems that we don't have to approve a device at this moment. Mrs. Paral I have heard parents want Empire because of the 1:1. Mr. Barger recommendations approve 1:1, Mrs. Karakal motion to accept the recommendation was seconded by Mrs. Paral, all were in favor. 1:1 was approved.

Motion was made by Mrs. Misciagna and was seconded by Mrs. Karakla school calendar was approved.

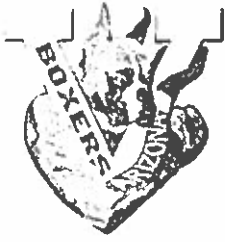

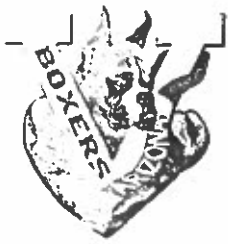

Mr. Barger reported on Vail Pride Day the large population of people cooking. Also reported on Game Night and the Soccer Tournament Mrs. Ellis was in charge of. Ground breaking ceremony held February 3<sup>rd</sup> on the news an article in the paper. The article is on the bulletin board across from Mr. Barger's office. Mr. Barger touched on the joint site council meeting that was held at Empire talking about the budget. There will be a Town Hall Meeting in March at Empire. AIMS testing start tomorrow the 23<sup>rd</sup> for Writing and the 24<sup>th</sup> for Reading. Student's not testing will come to school at 11:00 am. Mr. Barger talked a little about the new Technology Acceptable Use Policy having student's bring their own lab tops, iPhones etc. There will be a few bugs to work out but overall it seems to be a good idea.

F. Recognitions

Mr. Barger recognized Toby Peine for winning the HEAT Optimist Essay Contest. If he wins the next round he would move to the regionals and possible win of \$2,500.00. Jonah Hankins also won at Vail Pride Day for Colossal Cave essay contest. Mr. Barger also recognized several students that were working Vail Pride Day that helped a lady that was stuck in the mud. The lady that was helped brought cookies for Mr. Frausel and the students that helped. The principal from Seinta Valley told Mr. Barger "your kids are amazing. they are so organized and polite, so delightful. Their booth ran the best." Mr. Barger also recognized the help of Mr. Roberts and other VHS staff and students that helped when the rains came and started flooding the hall. Mr. Barger also recognized Mrs. Kaparoff for pulling together the food booth. Also, Mr. Barger recognized the Site Council for accomplishing a lot this school year.

## 2. Old Business

### **A. Enrollment Summary**

The number as of today is 154 same as last month. Mr. Barger shared with the council we are in good standing that we have never been at 154 in February. We have 53 full time VDLP and 8 part time VDLP students. Of this there will be 10 to 11 taking the AIMS testing. We are looking for the part time to go up in the next month or so to make up classes students are missing.

### **B. Construction Update**

Mr. Barger informed the council that construction may have lost 3 days due to the rain but believes they are on task. When the block is up you may not see things going on but there will be on the inside. All slabs have been poured. Basketball court slab should be poured. Right now we are at Lead Certified Gold almost to Platinum. Waiting for the roof to go on the MPR, Admin and elementary.

### **C. 10/11 Enrollment Update**

As of February 11<sup>th</sup> there are 85 students K-8, the 19<sup>th</sup> of February we went to 120 K-8. We are at cap for Kindergarten and 6th grade. We do have one extra room we could use for 6<sup>th</sup> grade. We will be having the lottery next week Friday, March 5<sup>th</sup>. During Vail Pride Day we gave out 18 enrollment packets. All 8<sup>th</sup> grade students were mailed a letter about Vail Academy and High School.

### **D. 10 / 11 Enrollment Update**

Mr. Barger brought to the attention of the council budget has been approved using bond \$ to pay for lab tops. The Vail FFE will match. Use of VDLP money is also available. I movie can be done in class lab. Looking at HP Lynux cheaper and will run windows. .

### **E. Senior Year Requirements**

Mr. Barger followed up with input and thoughts from last meeting on requirements for seniors to be in school 6 classes. Mr. Barger shared with the council the AIMS testing does well but after a while there is nothing to show. He also shared with the council 88% of high school students need remedial math in college. Top colleges expect 23.5 or higher on ACT scores. Mr. Barger shared with the council the university's that expect higher scores. Arkansas is 25.5, Texas is 27.5, and Stanford is 30 for scores on ACT. Ideal would be for seniors to take 5 to 6 classes. Graduation requirements will be changing. In 2011 students will be required to take 3 Math, 3 Science. In 2012 students will be required to take 4 Math and 3 Science. Some students leave after 4<sup>th</sup> to go to Pima to take classes. Pima is working on having classes at Cienega and Empire.

### **F. High School Grade Level Caps**

Mr. Barger shared with the council numbers for next year. The senior class will move on, junior class if all move forward we will have 44 seniors, 40 juniors, 43 sophomores. We are taking enrollment packets for all high school grades. Looks like 225 will be the target number for high school. The cap for high school looks like 70 for 9<sup>th</sup> grade 60 for 10<sup>th</sup> grade, 50 for 11<sup>th</sup> and 50 for 12<sup>th</sup> grade. If we go over the 70 for 9<sup>th</sup> grade we will need to have a lottery. Mr. Barger shared with the council the next time we meet we will know where we stand with numbers.

### 3. New Business

#### A. Staffing Updates

Mr. Barger shared with the council Mr. Rice will not be returning next year and will not finish this year out. We have had the same sub for the past 2 months. Mr. Barger has hired an engineer from Raytheon that will take the zero hour class for the remaining of the school year. Interviews have started for the new school and things are looking good. Hope to have K-8 staff hired by next meeting. Looking at hiring half PE, half Music teacher. The Art teacher will set up art supplies and lessons for elementary. Middle school teachers will split Math, Science, Social Studies and English.

#### B. State Budget

Mr. Barger shared an email he received from Mr. Calvin Baker in regards to the budget, does not look good. The Governor is proposing a 1% sales tax increase. Republicans did not ask for the tax increase and the Tea Party does not vote. Democrat's bad idea in AZ no legislative can vote for it. Leaving it up to the people. If this passes 2/3 will go towards schools. Parents have had enough. You can vote by mail by April. Four of five parents do not have school age children. Mr. Barger explained that as school district employee's we can talk about the vote when off the clock. We cannot tell people how to vote we can only give the facts

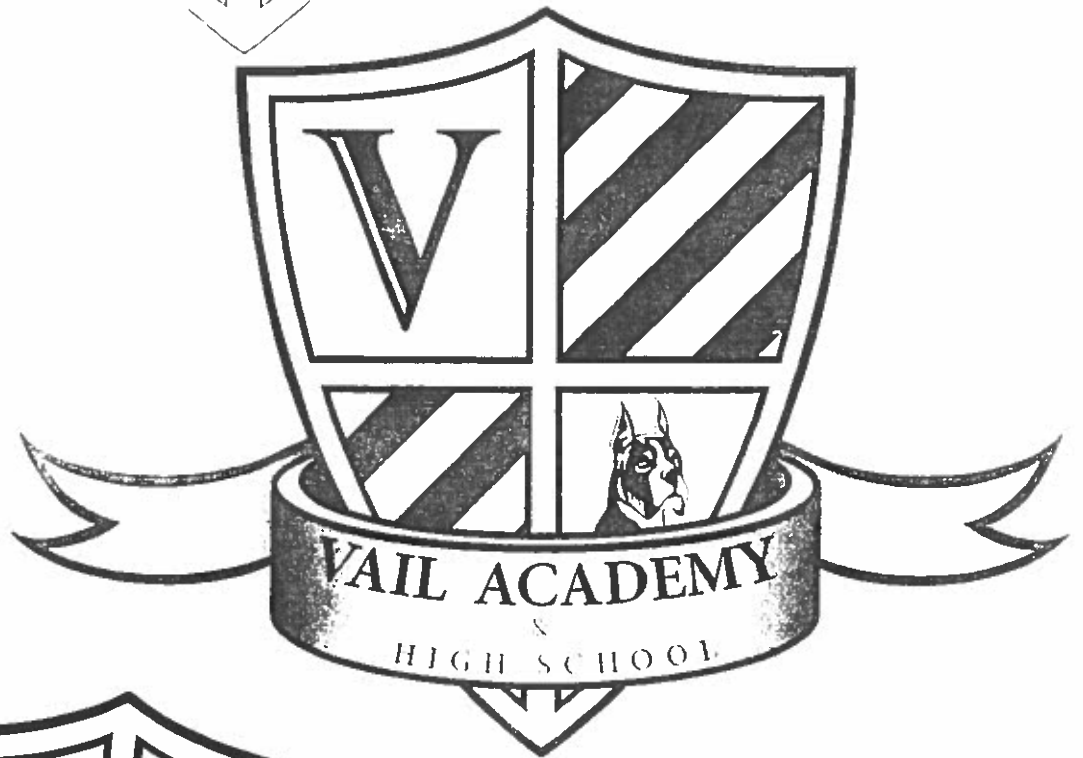

**VAHS Site Council Minutes**  
**For meeting held March 29, 2010**

Members Present: Jim Burns, Frances Massingill, Donna Misciagna, Christina Nickerson, Toby Peine, and Nancy Silva.

Mr. Burns called the meeting to order at 4:33 p.m. in room 3 of Vail High School.

Approval of Minutes: Motion made by Mrs. Misciagna, seconded by Mrs. Silva. Approved unanimously with no changes.

Reports: Mr. Barger reported on the state budget crisis. Vail anticipates anywhere from \$3.3 to \$7.1 million in hits to next year's district budget. That number is a moving target and more information will be forthcoming. Also a report on the upcoming AIMS and Stanford 10 testing was provided.

Call to the Public: None.

Recognitions: Mr. Barger recognized H.E.A.T. Optimist contest essay winners, **Toby Peine**, **Henry Hastings** and **Robbie Graham** pointing out that Toby won and was going to the state level competition. Mr. Barger recognized student, **Caitlyn Hall**, for being selected as having the best science fair project at SARSEF. Caitlyn will be going to San Jose in May and stand to win several thousand dollars. Finally, Mr. Barger recognized **Mr. Roberts** and **Ms. Banks** for their efforts in helping transition teachers and material to the moodle platform and working out the bugs for next year.

Old Business:

- A. Mr. Barger updated the council on enrollment numbers for the school as of 3/29/10.
- B. Mr. Barger informed the council on progress being made during construction of the new facility. The major concern is the water line, aside from that things are moving along on schedule.
- C. Mr. Barger provided a handout showing the current number of enrollment for next year on a grade by grade basis.
- D. After reviewing enrollment goals for the 2010-2011 school year on the high school side of campus at the previous meeting. Mr. Barger recommended that the council set the numbers for next year at 70, 60, 50 and 50 for grades 9-12 respectively. Mrs. Massingill motioned and Mrs. Misciagna seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

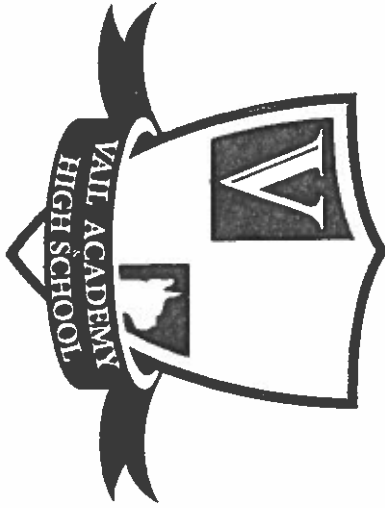
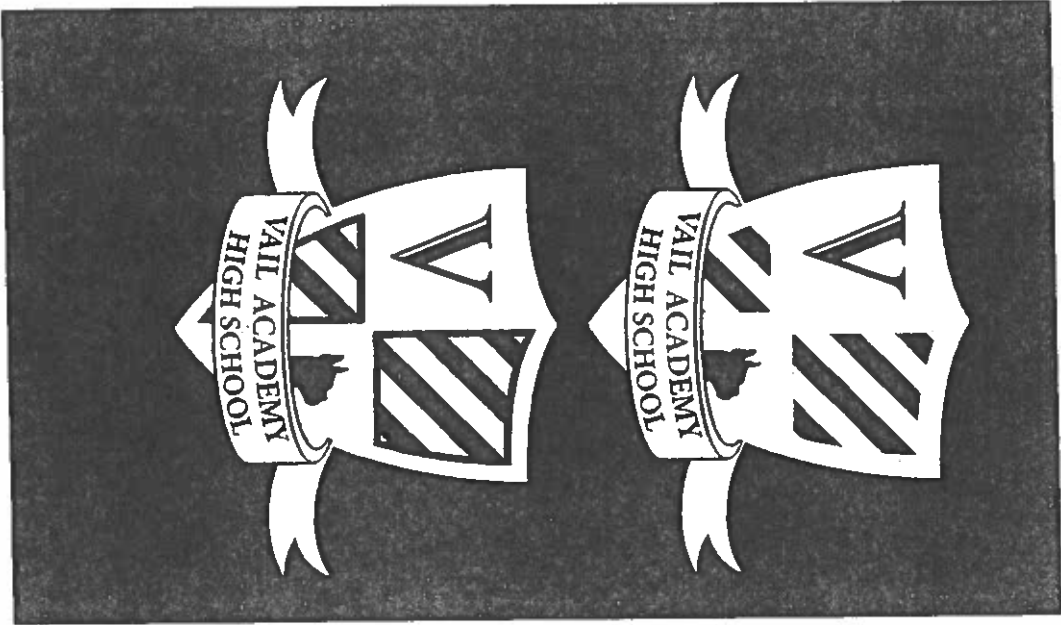

The Class of 2023  
Kindergarten 2010-2011  
Meeting 4-28-10

The intent of the Vail Academy and High School has been to offer full day Kindergarten for 2010-2011. This spring the Arizona Legislature approved two budgets (one with the sales tax passing and one if the sales tax fails). On both budgets, full-day kindergarten funding has been repealed. What does that mean for VAHS?

Currently our site council has approved an enrollment target of 20 for kindergarten with an additional three spots being available to accommodate siblings from other grades so that families can have all of their children enrolled.

The state of Arizona funded full-day kindergarten for **2009-2010** at \$3308.57 and used a multiplier of 1.158 for a total of \$3831.32 for the base funding level. They then add the "additional assistance" fund of \$794.22, for a total per pupil spending of \$4625.54.

The state of Arizona has two plans for funding kindergarten in **2010-2011**. If the **sales tax PASSES** on May 18, the starting amount is \$1654.29 (half of the 09-10 amount) times the multiplier of 1.158 equals \$1915.66. We then add the additional assistance of \$751.72, for a total of \$2667.38. This is a reduction of \$1958.16 per student or \$45,037.68 for the class.

If the **sales tax FAILS**, the state will reduce the starting point by 2% (from 3308.57 to \$3242.40, and then kinder is funded at half of that, or \$1621.20). Again the additional assistance is added, but a smaller number is used, \$619.22 for a total of \$2240.42. This a reduction of \$2385.12 per student. This a reduction of \$54,857.76 for the class.

We have several options to discuss:

1. Go to half day kindergarten
2. Keep full day kindergarten and take money from the other grades to subsidize
3. Have half day kindergarten and add kinder cottage
4. Have full day kindergarten and half is free the other half is paid for
5. Add more students to class to make it run more efficiently
6. Open for discussion

What are others doing?

Civano Community School has in the past and probably will again offer full day kindergarten. The morning is free and the afternoon is optional, but paid for by parents.

Catalina Foothills school district is requiring parents to pay \$4000 for full day kindergarten.
