Mr. Ogden motioned to approve minutes as presented. was seconded by Mrs. Misciagna. Minutes were approved.

Mr. Barger reported on the visits all the high schools did at the middle school for a parent evening. Mr. Baker spoke of how the children in Vail can pick the high school they want to attend. After Mr. Baker spoke, the principals spoke about their high schools. Mr. Barger also shared with the council he had taken 24 enrollment packs with him the first night and they were all taken. If this is any indication of interest it looks good for next year freshman class. April 20<sup>th</sup> will be the visits to the middle school during the day to meet the 8<sup>th</sup> graders.

Mr. Barger shared with the council AIMS testing and Terra Nova testing went very well. This is the first year for mandatory Biology AIMS testing. Juniors and Seniors also had the opportunity to take the Assessment for Pima Community College. This is the first time that PCC came to the school to test and place students.

Mr. Barger reported on the Pampered Chef fundraiser stating that the school made approximately 450.00.

## F. Recognitions

Mr. Barger recognized Don Adams, Terry Jensen and the Robotics Team for the competitions in San Diego and in Phoenix over Spring break. Mr. Barger gave a brief explanation on how the competition worked. VIIS advanced to the final round, and were eliminated by two points.

Mr. Barger also recognized Larry Rice. Mr. Rice teaches JTED classes and was able to start a program and received \$50,000 this year for computers and equipment.

Mr. Barger also recognized staff for proctoring AIMS and Terra Nova Testing.

Mrs. Kathy Watkins recognized Eva Peters, Don Adams and Chris Still for their help with the seniors in VDLP in getting their senior projects done and graduate them. Mrs. Watkins reported that as to date we have 4 that have graduated and 5 more by summer.

## 3. Old Business

### A. Enrollment Summary

INFORM

Mr. Barger shared with the council the numbers for March. Mr. Barger also shared that at this time last year we were at 133 students.

### B. Relocation

INFORM

Mr. Barger shared with the council at the last meeting it was mentioned by someone to someone else that since there is no money to build the preschool we should make the school a K-12 school. Mr. Barger took this to Mr. Carruth, who shared it with Mr. Baker and it is now being considered to be a K-12 school with the high school on one side and the elementary/middle school on the other. This would be the first district K-12 school. Big question needs to be answered. Is this a VIIS with a K-8 or is it one k-12 school. Mrs. Wood asked where we would get the students to fill the school. Mr. Barger explained how big the district boundaries are, 420 miles. Mrs. Watkins asked if we had middle school with high school how much interaction would there be with the high school students as well as the elementary students. How would lunch's work. Mr. Barger explained that high school kids are great with the little kids and that lunches would be staggered. The big issue is the name. Mr. Ogden shared that your name is your branding. General concern is the high school should stay Vail High School.

### C. Attendance Policy

ACTION

Mr. Barger gave a little background on the situation. Had a student missed three days, missed four more days came in one day missed another 8 days. State requires that after 10 consecutive days unexcused absence the student will be dropped as a 10 day consecutive absence. Mr. Barger also shared with the council that the state now recognizes suspensions as an excused absence; therefore we can not drop them if they have been suspended for 10 days. Mr. Barger recommended the council approve adding to the agenda "The administration reserves the right to require a doctor's note explaining absences and the readmission for any student who has missed a minimum of three consecutive school days." Mrs. Watkins motioned to approve the wording Mrs. Wood seconded the motions all were in favor motion approved.

### D. 2009-2010 Agenda

ACTION

Mr. Barger explained to the council the existing language in the agenda for student conduct and dress code pages 12, 13 and 14. Page 12 is the last line is bold, "Finally, all clothing shall be sufficient to conceal undergarments at all times including

Page 13 under Pants/Shorts, "worn on the natural waist" will be bold and add to cover undergarments, and add slippers in bold.

Page 13 under Outerwear to take out or keep "Trench coats ay not be worn to school. The council motioned to take the statement out.

Page 13 under footwear: To bold the last sentence "Flip-flops, slippers, elevator shoes, and stiletto heels are not acceptable.

Page 13 under Jewelry/Accessories: to bold the last sentence, "Earrings and studs and other piercing jewelry may be worn only in the ear and the number may not be excessive. Lip rings, Eyebrow rings, and nose piercing are not allowed at any time. No gauging of the ears will be permitted on campus. Mrs. Watkins asked the question what is excessive. Mr. Barger explained it would be administration decision.

Mr. Ogden motioned to approve the changes as read, Mrs. Watkins second the motion. Changes were approved.

#### **4. New Business**

##### **A. Saturday school stipend**

**ACTION**

Mr. Barger shared with the council that Saturday school would start Saturday, April 4<sup>th</sup>. Saturday would be for students that are on academic probation. This will be a good time for students to get their work done and catch up on work that needs to be done. If a student comes to Saturday school with no work to do they will clean. Saturday will be from 7:30 am to 11:30 am. Mr. Barger asked the council to approve an 80.00 stipend to be paid to the teacher that comes in for Saturday morning to do Saturday School. Mr. Ogden motioned to approve the 80.00 stipend Mrs. Misciagna seconded recommendation was approved.

##### **B. NCA Process**

**STUDY**

Mr. Barger shared with the council the process of NCA and what it is. Every few years schools go through a process to receive their accreditations. The committee from around the state will be here in three weeks to do our evaluation. The committee will interview several staff, parents and students. Mr. Barger also shared that several staff have finished up the pre-questions and sent the information off.

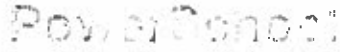
