Administrative Reports

Mr. Barger shared with the council the Bio Blitz field trip is Friday, October 21st. We have all 7th and 8th grade going along with 14 high school students from the Environmental Science class. There will be over 2000 students from school all over the Tucson area. The students will be tagging Saguaro cactus at the Saguaro National Park. The Bio Blitz will be Friday and Saturday.

Mr. Barger also shared with the council the K-6 had their awards assembly and the change in format for awards. The awards were attendance, citizenship, and principal. .

Mr. Barger shared with the council that Saturday, October 22nd is "Make a Difference Day" and that we were selected by the LDS Church of Rita Ranch to help clean up the school. They will be planting trees in the playground area, removing dead grass and weeds on the soccer field and painting a hop scotch court for the elementary side playground. We will have about 30 to 40 people here Saturday.

Mr. Barger recognized Mrs. Denise Paral office staff for here 3 years here at VAHS. Mrs. Paral over the break accepted a job at the district office and will be leaving VAHS. He thanked her for her contribution in the office, serving on the site council and for feeding everyone.

Mr. Barger also recognized Mrs. Yvett Rojo, Ms. Julia Kaiser and Mr. John Roberts for their hard work and dedication to the new VAHS web site.

2. Consent Agenda

Motion was made by Mrs. Smith and seconded by Mrs. Justen. Consent agenda was approved.

2. Old Business

Mr. Barger asked the council if we could move Old Business A and move right onto B and C in old and new business.

B. Graduation Materials

The site council heard presentation's from two vendors for graduation materials (cap/gown/announcements ext) The first presentation was with Joe Grossi with Jostens and than Bill Waldrup with Rembrant/Herff Jones.

C. Graduation Materials

Mr. Barger shared with the council that decision needed to be made tonight on which company to pick for gap/gown and ext. A vote was taken and Mr. Barger recommends that Herff Jones be the company for the graduation materials. Motion to accept Herff Jones was made by Mrs. Whitlow and was seconded by Mrs. Justen all were in favor but 2 Mrs. Greasy and Ms. Witzen.

A. Enrollment Summary

Mr. Barger shared with the council the enrollment numbers as of today. We have 472 of which 182 are K-6th grade and 85 are 7th and 8th grade and 205 are 9th to 12th grade with 11 foreign exchange students. There is a waiting list for all grades except high school. Mr. Barger was talking to the council regarding next year's enrollment and where we may be short in high school with Andrada Polytechnic High School opening. Mr. Barger also shared that before moving to the new school our high school was at 150 to 160. We will lose students going on to Andrada. Mr. Barger shared that we may want to consider having double 6th, 7th and 8th grades. If the over ride does not pass we will lose 2 to 3 staff members. We can cut the high school down to 150 to 160 and double up the middle school to cover the kids we lose to the other schools. Question was asked about when we have to make the decision on whether to take on the double grades. Mr. Barger did say that he would like to make the decision no later than December so that will give teachers the opportunity to move on to another high school if they do not want to teach middle school. Also, Mr. Barger informed the council of the school on DMAFB and that we may not have students from there if their school improves.

2. New Business

A. Senior Portrait Photographer

The council heard a presentation from Herff Jones Rembrandt on senior pictures. The council was able to ask questions and was given the opportunity to see senior pictures from past years. The other company did not show for their presentation.

B. Senior Portrait Photographer

Mr. Barger recommended that the council take a vote on the photographer for VAHS Senior's. Vote was taken all were in favor. Motion was made by Mrs. Smith to go with Herff Jones for senior portraits was seconded by Mrs. Justen all were in favor Herff Jones/Rembrandt will be the senior photographer for their senior portraits.

C. 2012-2013 Enrollment

Discussion was on the table whether to go double 6th, 7th and 8th grade classes and lower the numbers for high school. This was tabled and a decision was made to have an answer by December 2011.

12-13 Issues to consider

VA Waiting list k-8, two years in a row.

VHS Empty spots in every grade this year and three grades last year.

VHS Students that may not return next year (For. Exch. and DMAFB #s)(10+15)

Andrada Poly opens next year. will hold 500-600 kids.

OPTIONS:

KEEP 230 HS SPOTS AND RECRUIT

- + Keeps HIS Teachers as they are
- + Allows us to keep options that we have now
- Uncertainty of recruiting based on prior numbers and Andrada opening
- Loss of filled spots is paid for by k-8 over crowding
- Which student do we get if we do fill? TUSD, SSide or Vail?

DOUBLE THE MIDDLE SCHOOL GRADES AND LOWER HIS NUMBERS

- + Likely to fill MS numbers faster than HS numbers. currently waiting list of 30 for 6th
- + We already have a double 8th grade for next year, which would likely be hardest to fill
- + We shift 'recruiting' from 9th grade to 6th grade when we are the only 'other' choice
- + We likely get more Vail families than out of district students
- + Majority of our 9th grade class would already know our school culture. transition easier
- + We could build a waiting list at HIS classrooms allowing us leverage for under performing students
- We could lose existing staff who do not wish to teach MS students
- We may attract fewer quality students because we are 'too small' or don't have programs
