Regular Meeting

I. Call to Order

Meeting was called to order by Mrs. Lain-Young at 3:10 pm. In attendance was: Mr. Barger, Mr. Jensen, Ms Vining, Mrs. Lain-Young and Mrs. Sheehy.

A. Pledge of Allegiance

Lead by Mrs. Lain-Young

B. Approval of Minutes

Mrs. Vining motioned to approve minutes as read and was seconded by Mr. Jensen.

C. Reports

Mrs. Lain-Young asked to have financial update at next meeting in regards to the new school.

*** Administrative Report**

Mr. Barger informed the council that Irma Woodward has resigned from the council due to her new employment at the District Office. Mrs. Woodward worked between the district and VHS for a couple of weeks. Cindy Petersen will be the new office clerk. Mrs. Petersen was previously Mr. Barger's secretary over at Cienega. Miss McKinney is on a field trip today and this is why she is not at the meeting.

Mr. Barger informed the council that Mr. D'Auria has resigned from Athletic Director and that John Floro and Ryan Kaparoff will act as Assistant Athletic Director. Mr. Barger gave an update on the 2 day Safe School training days and their success. There were 26 students and a couple of parents that attended this 2 day training. We are going to introduce the Smart Option Program in advisor base.

E. Recognitions

Mr. Barger recognized Mr. Roberts for coordinating the PSAT and being here on a Saturday for the students to take the PSAT. Mr. Barger also recognized a number of parents that helped in the Safe School Program. Mr. Barger also wanted to thank Dr. Brown for giving a room upstairs in the UofA for the training. Also, Mr. Barger recognized Mrs. Keenen, Mr. & Mrs. Thrall, Ms. Jones, students and staff that came in over the break and helped with painting, cleaning, filing and just helping in getting the school ready for the new 9 weeks. Mr. Barger recognized Mrs. Sheehy for coordinating the Safe School Ambassador and Smart Option Programs.

Mrs. Lain-Young recognized Rebecca Adams one of our students for entering Raytheon Women on the move. Rebecca was the only female student in the City of Tucson to enter. Mrs. Lain-Young would like to see more girls send in essays. Mrs. Lain-Young also wanted to thank Mr. Barger and Mrs. Sheehy for having her attend the Safe School Ambassador training. She would

like to see this tailored to the public. Mr. Barger informed the council that 2 of the Vail schools have completed this training.

2. Consent Agenda

3. Old Business

A. Enrollment Summary

Mr. Barger informed the council of the enrollment up to date, enrollment is at 147 with last month being at 143 we are up 4.

B. Vail's Cares Incentive

Mr. Barger updated the council on the expenditures of the Vail's Cares Grant.

C. Name the Boxer

Mr. Barger updated the council on the names picked for the Boxer. Mr. Barger asked what the council thought of the name "Rocky". Mrs. Lain-Young motioned to except the name "Rocky" and was seconded by Ms. Vining.

D. School Construction Update

INFORM

Mr. Barger shared with the council the front page of the newspaper had an article of KB Homes and the land swap with the UofA. The process is in the hands of the Vail District attorneys with the UofA. Mr. Barger will keep the council informed as he hears of the progress. There is no date as such for the move for the new school. The funds we received from the military are set aside for us in the sum of \$535,000.00.

4. New Business

A. Policy for New Student Enrollment

STUDY

Mr. Barger presented to the council new student enrollment situations. Mr. Barger informed the council that we have students transferring from one school to the other and some coming from out-of-state.

B. Policy for New Student Enrollment

ACTION

Mr. Jensen and Mrs. Sheehy would like to see a standard bar that teachers will work with. What to do when students come from other schools mid year with no grades. Mrs. Lain-Young had some concerns of students coming in mid year and not knowing the material. The concern seems to be with freshmen more so. Could we use on line courses to get students caught up? Concerns seem to be more so with English, Math and Spanish. It is hard for a student to come in mid year not ever having Spanish and need to jump right in. Mr. Jensen spoke of the after school tutoring and maybe having new students do the after school tutoring to get somewhat caught up. We have after school tutoring 4 nights a week, we do have an activity bus to take the students home. Do not excuse the students from the concept but maybe from some of the work. Maybe have the student take a test to see where they are as far as competency in the subject. Some items that can not be made up in the class to get the student up to par are bell work, and open Labs. Mrs. Lain-Young asked Mr. Barger if there is no policy. It would be better to come up with a procedure to allow the student to know what is expected of them when they enroll mid way. Mr. Barger stated that he could recommend inter-session for those students. We do not give .25 credits for a quarter grades. We only give semester grades. Mr. Barger stated that he does not like to lose students but we do need to draw a line as far as how long we will enroll students and when we stop. Mr. Barger will look into grant money to see if there is a way to come up with an exam to test the students when they come to the school so late in the year. Mr. Barger will be speaking to the staff and get their opinion. Mrs. Lain-Young asked Mr. Barger what a packet based school was. Mr. Barger explained it is a school that gives packets to students and they complete them at their own time. The council agreed to table this policy for another meeting, and to get input from the staff.

C. Business Card Key Stats

STUDY

Mr. Barger asked the council about new business cards and gave an example of what he thought the council was speaking of. The council would like to see business cards that have information of VHS on them. It was suggested to have information such as a Bar Graph with AIMS results, recognitions. Something to show who we are.

D. Telephone Changes

INFORM

Mr. Barger informed the council of the phone changes in the district. The Vail area has grown so fast that we will now have our own prefix. All schools in the district will go to 879 prefix. The change should be complete by January 2007. Mr. Jensen told the council of how the new phone system will work. The phones will be on computer lines and that the phones can be taken anywhere. With the new phone system there will be no phone service, and there will be no monthly service fees. We will save money in the long run. Mr. Jensen also informed the council there may be some equipment we may have to update. Once the change has been made there will be a forwarding message to let people know that the number has been changed. Mr. Barger informed the council that the UofA has kindly let us out of our phone contract, so VHS will be moving to the 879 prefix.

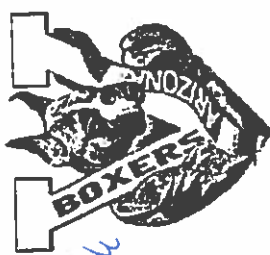

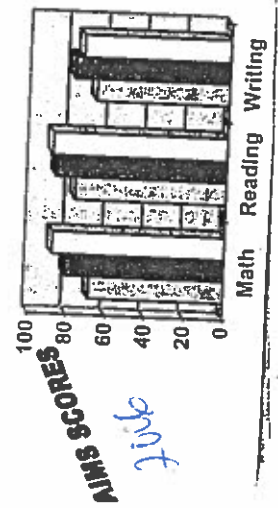
