Regular Meeting

1. **Call to Order**

Meeting was called to order by Mr. Letcher at 3:07 pm. In attendance: Mr. Barger, Mr. Roberts, Miss Amanda Scrimpsheer, Mr. Letcher, Mrs. Petersen, Mrs. Sheehy and Ms. Vining

Mr. Barger introduced Miss Amanda Scrimpsheer will be taking over as the student representative.

*** Administrative Report**

Mr. Barger shared with the council the meeting with 8th grade parents that was held at Desert Sky Middle school there were about 400 parents in attendance to meet all three high school principals. There was a very good response of parents interested in Vail High School.

Mr. Barger shared with the council of a new program that Vail High School is looking into. Mr. Adams, Mr. Frausel, Mr. Jensen and Mr. Barger will be looking in a Lap Top program for students. The program will be a trial with juniors and seniors.

Mr. Barger spoke of the Fourth Annual FORE VHS Golf Tournament that will be held Saturday, May 12, 2007 at Santa Rita Golf Course. We are looking for golfers, sponsors and prizes for raffle/silent auction.

E. Recognitions

Mr. Barger recognized Mrs. Eva Peters for her help with the American Legion Post 109 essay. We have 3 of the 4 Arizona students that won the contest. Tatiana Stroitlyeva, and Jack Young. Mr. Roberts and Ms. Michelle Marlatt for post cards to communicate with parents. Mr. Roberts for VDLP post cards that have general information of them to show how their student is doing.

Mrs. Petersen recognized one of VHS students Matthew Levitt for his hard work on getting the school library in order and how proud Matthew is of his work and accomplishment.

3. Old Business

A. Enrollment Summary

INFORM

Mr. Barger shared with the council the enrollment as of February 16th at which time VHS has 144 students. 41, 9th grade 27 boys, 14 girls, the senior class has 7 boys 15 girls. One student withdrew today and that brought the enrollment to 143.

B. Enrollment Process Update

INFORM

February 2, 2007 all enrollment packets need to be turned in to all three high schools. If VHS receives more enrollment packets after the February 2nd deadline and we are at 33 freshmen we will continue to take enrollment packs until we get to 46. Mr. Letcher asked if the junior and senior class is over but the sophomore and freshmen class are low would we take more students even if we are at the max. Mr. Barger explained that he does not want to go over the maximum number of student VHS can hold.

C. Student Appeals of NC

INFORM

Mr. Barger explained to the council that there was a lengthy discussion of appealing grades for students that received NC on their report card. This would be due to excessive absences. Mr. Barger shared how the other High School handles the appeal process. There is a form that the student needs to complete and an explanation of why they think they should get a chance to fix the NC. The support or decline credit form would go into the teacher's box for them to complete. The teacher will complete the form with an explanation on if they believe the student should or should not get the credit. At this time we have only 3 students that fall into this area. Mr. Letcher commented of the three students at this point were the days justified of why they missed school. At this point only one has come forth to appeal her grade. Mr. Barger would like to explain to the council the reason for the student not receiving credit after at which time there will be the principal, one council member and a staff member it will be a 2 to 3 vote.

D. New Phones

INFORM

Mr. Barger informed the council the Vail School District has switched from the 762 prefix to 879 prefix. Mr. Barger was asked what number he would like for VHS and he chose 1900. Therefore, Vail High School's new number will be 879-1900. The first ten digits will be consistent with all schools in the district. The UofA has released us from our contract for the phones.

4. New Business

A. Distinction Point Start Date

INFORM

Site Council last year approved the distinction point for validation and how to implement them. It can and will make a difference to three of our students here at VHS. It will change the top student rank. An example was given to the council of how this would work and how it would impact the top three students. Mr. Barger explained from the samples he handed out just how this would work.

B. Distinction Point Start Date

ACTION

Mr. Barger explained to the council how Honors, Pima Community College and AP credits would work. Mrs. Petersen asked if colleges look at the GPA and the student took Honors, AP or PCC classes and do we give them the credit for the last semester and would this effect the ranking for scholarships. Mrs. Sheehy, since it has been approved, will the credits be retroactive? If a student comes in as a senior has had a lot of honors from another school and a student from VHS has taken AP and Pima classes how do you determine who would be top of the class? What do you do if a student takes AP classes but does not take the test, do they still get the credit as an AP class. Do we count 9th and 10th graders? It was discussed that the student should have completed 8 semesters of AP, Honors or Pima classes to receive the credit with a passing grade of a B. The council decided to count grades from other schools. It was also asked how long a student should be in attendance with VHS to be considered Valedictorian and Salutatorian; they should be in attendance for at least 2 years. Mrs. Sheehy motioned to start the distinction point, was seconded by Mrs. Petersen.

C. Vail Cares Survey Results

STUDY

Mr. Barger shared with the council on the survey Mrs. St. John had given the staff and the results. He was not too concerned of the outcome considering VIIS had such a big turn over in the past year. All council members were given a copy of the results. Mr. Barger meet with students on the snow day and they were asked questions regarding to VIIS. All council members were given a copy of the results. Based on all the information staff reviewed this information and listed 3 categories they think VIIS should focus on: Culture, Academic Programs and Family School.

D. Vail Cares Target Goals

ACTION

There was a discussion on the three goals set for VHS: Culture, Academic Programs and Family School. Some feel we have started on the Culture, VHS is a safe, clean environment, and there is a conference room to have meetings. Mrs. Sheehy motioned to accept the three goals are stated above, Mrs. Petersen seconded the motion all were in favor.
