Our volleyball program exists for the benefit and development of our players. My coaching philosophy involves mutual respect, commitment, and dedication on behalf of each player to prepare, participate and grow as a player. Our program will focus on character building while improving their volleyball skills. Key to this development is good discipline, strong work ethic, teamwork and a good sense of fun! All players should exhibit these characteristics. I will teach players to set goals, keep these goals in focus and achieve them. The ultimate purpose of our volleyball program is for each student-athlete to have fun, while acquiring good skills and discipline. I would like our volleyball program to enrich and better the lives of each player. It is an integral supplement to the already superior education available at Vail Academy and High School.

Rules and Expectations:

Eligibility- No student can participate in a game if they don't have a current physical, a signed code of conduct, emergency card on file, transportation card and pay the fee (you may use your tax credit to do so). Students must maintain a 2.0 average, and have no "F's". Student-athletes that are ineligible for three weeks will be removed from the team roster. Students who are ineligible may practice but may not play in games or sit with the team during games.

Practice times- Practice is Mon-Thu, from 2:45pm-4:15pm, with the exception of game days or otherwise directed by the Coach (See schedule for details). Every student-athlete is expected to be at practice. A written note from a parent or teacher is required for all missed practices. If a student misses practices without a note, students risk losing their spot on the team.

Game times- All games will start at 3:45pm. A copy of the games schedule will be issued to every student-athlete and parents for planning purposes.

Sportsmanship- I expect students and parents to exhibit good sportsmanship at all times. If a student-athlete's behavior is a detrimental distraction to the team, they may be suspended from play or removed from the team roster.

Playing Time- Student-athlete playing time will be based on performance at practice. The coach will make an effort to see that all student-athletes play in every game if possible.

There will be an "A" Team- Varsity, and a "B" Team- Developmental if there are enough girls to field both teams. Additionally we may schedule C team games for players to gain extra playing time and experience. The schedule will reflect that information and I will notify players before games if they will be playing extra.

Uniforms- Each girl will have to purchase their own pair of black spandex shorts. Athletes should wear sport socks and tennis shoes. The uniform top will be issued to the student-athlete and must be returned immediately after the final game at the close of the season or a Late Uniform Notice will be sent out. Any uniforms that are lost or stolen must be reported to the coach immediately. *The replacement cost of the jerseys is \$40.00* to be turned in at the front office only.
